

Did You Know?

- ✓ **In the state of Arkansas, Gifted and Talented education is mandated K-12.**
- ✓ **Pre-AP and AP are governed by the Office of Gifted and Talented at the Arkansas Department of Education. Therefore, they are under the Gifted Programs umbrella at GCT.**
- ✓ **G/T programs are governed by state laws, the Gifted and Talented Program Approval Standards, and ADE regulations.**
- ✓ **Twice Exceptional is a term used to identify a student who qualifies for services as both a special needs student and a G/T student.**
- ✓ **All students in grades K-2 receive Whole Group Instruction from a G/T Specialist 30 minutes a week.**
- ✓ **Identified gifted and talented students must have a minimum of 150 minutes of instructional time with a G/T Specialist each week.**
- ✓ **There are over 300 identified PACE students and over 800 students in Pre-AP and AP classes. There are collectively over 1100 open files on these students.**
- ✓ **One of the requirements to be an Honor Graduate at GCT is completing AP courses. Check your handbook for more information on Honor Graduate requirements.**
- ✓ **GCT High School offers 19 AP classes. That is more**

than any other school in North East Arkansas.
